Building Logistics

- South side entrance on Jackson St.
- East side entrance on Michigan Ave.
- Elevator bank on North Side of the building (Michigan Ave.)
- Turnstile to access elevators and 2nd floor dining area
- Elevator Bank on North Side of Building
- 2nd Floor: Classroom on East Side of Building
 - Suite Keypad Code: 1397#
 - Restroom Keypad Code: 1487#
- 3rd Floor: Classroom on South Side of Building
 - Door Code: 1397#
 - Restroom: Swipe Card only
- Two Stairwells on the North and South Sides of the building

Turnstile Logistics

- Each student is issued a uniquely numbered white access card in addition to the Irish1Card
- Once scanned at the turnstile, you are granted access to elevators and a second set of turnstiles granting access needed to enter Suite 220 (Dining Room)
- White access cards are needed each residency and anytime you come to campus after hours
- Access to building due to forgotten card is gained by showing ID at security desk (1st floor) and they will print a temporary day/weekend pass for you to use
- Lost cards replaced for a \$30 charge to you
- Replacement holders are available, see Christine or Priscilla

After Hours (before 8:00 a.m. and/or after 6:00 p.m.)

- Use Michigan Avenue entrance
- Check-In (possible) at Security Desk (near 1st floor elevators) with your name and Irish1Card along with white access card
- 2nd Floor
 - Enter through the breakout room door equipped with a keypad (south side of atrium) (1397#)
 - You only will be permitted access to the breakout rooms and the business center portions of the suite.
- 3rd Floor
 - All you need to enter the 3rd floor space is the door code (1397#)
 - You only will be permitted access to the breakout rooms and servery

Breakout Rooms

- Availability (non-class days)
- First-come, first-served no reservations
- Other ND affiliates may reserve the space on non-residency weekends preventing usage
- 2nd floor breakout rooms are accessible via the hallway using the keypad code 1397#

Safety Precautions

- Please do not keep your valuables unattended as 224 S. Michigan is a public space with a restaurant and two bars
- Avoid leaving personal items in the 2nd floor dining room or in view of the windows into the suite
- If you are ever concerned about a situation, please call the building Security Desk at (312) 341–9436 and inform a staff member
- In case of emergencies first call 911, then call (312) 341–9436 to notify building management of emergency situation, and inform a staff member
